COURSE DEVELOPMENT AND ALIGNMENT

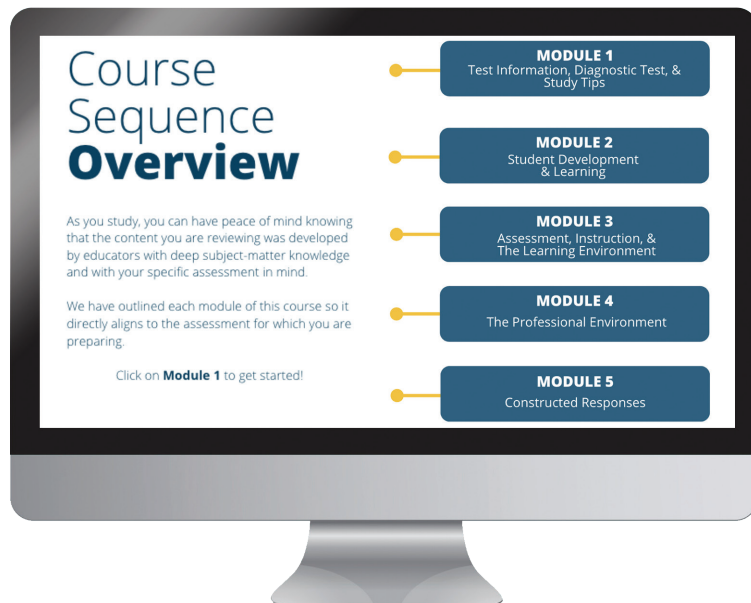
Passage Preparation™ provides affordable, high-quality resources aligned to state licensure standards and corresponding tests for prospective teachers preparing to take their state licensure assessments. We provide in-depth content, interactive activities, and formative and summative assessments to allow candidates to identify areas of focus for mastering key concepts as they prepare to take their licensure assessments. Passage Preparation™ courses engage candidates by presenting approachable subject-matter content aligned to specific standards and instructional activities to support mastery of state competencies and success on licensure assessments.

Our courses are developed by expert educators for prospective educators in order to provide in-depth content and test preparation aligned to licensure assessments used by states across the country. Passage Preparation™ content writers analyze and break down state educator standards and then build interactive, asynchronous courses which provide multiple opportunities for candidates to identify a study plan, review content covered on the assessment, check their understanding, and respond to items designed to emulate the actual test.

COURSE STRUCTURE

All of our courses are housed in Canvas, a learning management system that allows for structured delivery of content and activities. Our courses provide an overview of the assessment to which the course is aligned as well as test-taking strategies so that candidates are well-prepared on test day. Candidates then take a diagnostic assessment including approximately 40 multiple-choice questions designed in the same style of the actual assessment. They receive feedback after taking the diagnostic assessment which helps them to develop a study plan so they can work through the course at their own pace and in an order that best suits their needs.

▶ **MODULES:** Candidates move through modules that provide in-depth content as well as key takeaways and interactive activities.



▶ **CHECK FOR UNDERSTANDING:** These activities help candidates apply the content they just reviewed throughout the module and provide an indicator of their level of mastery.



▶ **ASSESSMENT:** Finally, candidates take a final assessment of approximately 100 multiple choice questions, again receiving feedback for each item once they complete the assessment. These items are randomized and candidates can take the final assessment (as well as the diagnostic assessment) as many times as necessary to feel prepared and confident when they take their actual licensure test. Candidates also receive an outcomes mastery report showing their level of mastery through their Passage Preparation account.

STATE STANDARDS AND TESTING REQUIREMENTS

We begin by identifying content standards and testing requirements for teacher certification by state. Often, candidates must take more than one test for a given certification area, such as a pedagogy assessment as well as content-area assessments.

We have identified the certification areas by state as well as the most frequently taken assessments and analyzed the standards to which those assessments are aligned to develop course content.

We analyze these assessments by standard, domain, and competency to identify what teachers are expected to know and be able to demonstrate on each test, specifically focusing on key terminology and skills to guide our content-writing process.

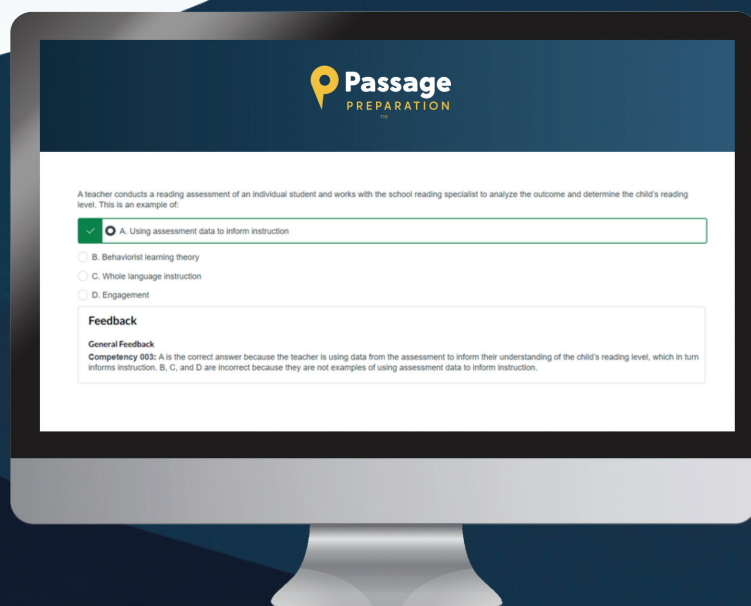

edTPA® Simplified: Your Guide to Success

The edTPA® is a national performance-based assessment used to evaluate candidates' readiness to teach. It requires candidates to plan instruction, deliver and video-record a learning segment, assess student learning, and reflect on their instructional decisions. edTPA® Simplified breaks down each task and rubric into clear, manageable steps. Our course supports candidates in understanding the assessment's structure, producing strong submissions, and demonstrating the skills needed for success.

Foundations of Reading™

The Foundations of Reading™ (FOR™) assessment is used by states including Alabama, Arkansas, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Mississippi, New Hampshire, North Carolina, Ohio, Rhode Island, Utah, and Wisconsin. This assessment includes content related to how students learn to read, reading instruction, and effective reading assessment.
